We begin in **BARCELONA**, where the city’s favorite playful architect, Gaudi, took nature as his inspiration and added his outrageous flourishes. Full of history of innovative spirit, this walkable Mediterranean city is all about work-life balance. Catalans love to work almost as much as they love to play – plenty of restaurants, cafés, museums and theaters packed with a mix of locals, expats and tourists. The weather is mild enough for palm trees and droves of parrots, and there are loads of experiences for outdoor enthusiasts, shoppers, foodies and art aficionados. Next, the voyage begins, skirting the coastline of Spain and out through the **STRAIGHT OF GIBRALTAR**, a 36-mile long and 8-mile wide channel connecting the Mediterranean Sea with the Atlantic Ocean, and separating Europe from Africa. First stop: **CANARY ISLANDS**. Off the coast of Africa but part of Spain, it’s a blissful place to spend a sunny day, and there’s ample opportunity for exceptional hiking nearby. Two days, and two islands to explore. Then, sit back and enjoy a week at sea crossing the Atlantic – a perfect time to start that novel, knit a blanket, learn a language, enjoy the posse camaraderie, participate in the TBE scavenger hunts, book clubs and game days, or enjoy the RCCL onboard activities. Next port of call: the archipelagic state of the **BAHAMAS**, consisting of more than 700 islands, cays and islets in the Atlantic Ocean – from white-sand beaches to gently lapping waves, world-class diving into blue holes to hiking national parks, romantic afternoons spent on deserted island beaches to day trips on fishing boats. Last stop: **TAMPA**. Stay an extra night, or homeward bound.
