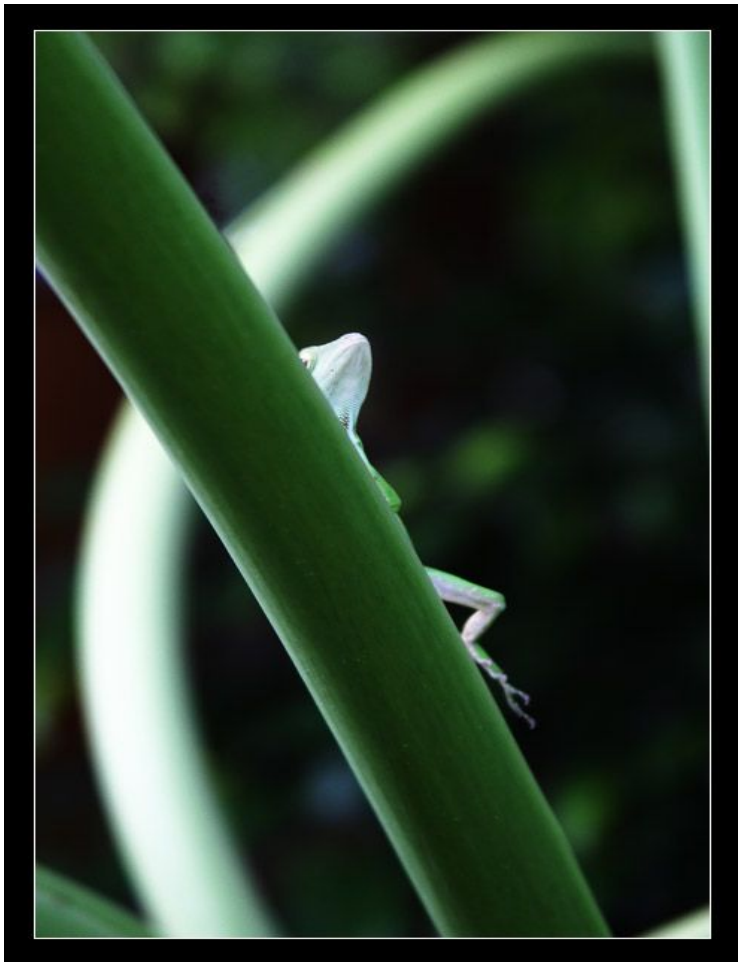

Voted by Condé Nast as one of the best hotels in Central America and set on a 30-acre coffee plantation, this luxurious colonial hacienda-style hotel features unique architecture, captivating grounds, exceptional service and a relaxing ambiance. Colonial-style rooms offer antique-reproduction furniture, Juliet balconies, Marriott's Revive Collection bedding, TV and minibars. TBE guests also receive complimentary high speed internet access and access to the executive lounge where morning, afternoon and evening snacks are served along with alcoholic beverages. Experience fine dining, exquisite tapas and wines at La Isabela, swim in one of two outdoor pools, sip coffee at their roasting café, or pamper yourself at the coffee-inspired spa.



**EL SILENCIO ECO LODGE & SPA – Bajos del Toro** (April 8 & 9)

In the country that practically invented ecotourism, El Silencio sets a new standard for responsible luxury. The 15 khaki-colored cottages are built of environmentally friendly materials such as bamboo tiles, with



lamp bases and towel racks fashioned from logs and twigs. All cottages are furnished with a king-size bed, two plush sofas that can double as extra sleeping nooks, and a gas fireplace to cut the morning chill. They are plenty roomy, but the biggest draw is beyond the sliding glass doors. As you watch the late-afternoon mist slide over the lushly forested mountains from your cottage's rail-less porch, you'll know why this is called the cloud forest. The largely local staff are ever present and will accompany you on your included guided walk through the adjacent 500-acre reserve to several waterfalls (some gushers and others trickles). Perhaps you'll want to practice yoga on the open-air platform at the spa. Chef Marco González's

Costa Rican–fusion food is among the best in the country, sourced from the resort's own organic garden and nearby purveyors of produce and naturally-raised chicken and fish. All gourmet meals are included!

NOTE: There are only 15 cottages at El Silencio (max 30 passengers, dbl occ). However, the nearby Bosque de Paz Resort & Biological Reserve ([www.bosquedepaz.com](http://www.bosquedepaz.com)) can host up to 10 more passengers. Guests opting to stay at the less luxurious, but equally eco and green Bosque de Paz will receive a \$125 pp credit. Groups (from both lodges) will participate in the included and optional activities together.

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**TABACÓN SPRINGS RESORT & SPA – Arenal Volcano/La Fortuna** (April 10 & 11). [www.tabacon.com](http://www.tabacon.com).

This award-winning 114-room resort (a member of the Leading Hotels of the World) next to Volcán Arenal has natural hot springs of steaming water that are channeled into numerous private pools and springs tailor-made for romantic moments. There are also several waterfalls where you can get an all-natural massage; if that's too exposed, there's an on-site Grand Spa hidden among tropical flowers where you can arrange an alfresco rubdown. There's the requisite swim-up bar in the main pool, but El Palenque (in a secluded corner of the lush gardens) is a less crowded watering hole and all the better for it. The views of Volcán Arenal are spectacular, especially since the volcano blows its top unpredictably, but nightly. Tabacón is perfect for those seeking serious R&R. The rooms are luxurious with some of the dark-wood furnishings made by local craftspeople.



**LOS SUEÑOS LUXURY VILLAS – Herradura Bay**

These private 3-bedroom/3-bath *en suite* luxury villas share a common gourmet kitchen, living room, dining room, laundry room, outdoor patio and semi-private infinity pool (pictured to the left). TBE guests have privileges at the Los Sueños golf course, 200-slip marina (world class sport fishing), private Beach Club with swim-up bar, 10+ restaurants, casino, and day spa.

**JUNGLE LODGE – Pacuare Rain Forest** (April 6 & 7)

Before you can cross the suspended foot bridge to your bungalow, you must first be handy with an oar. Tucked into a private reserve near the Caribbean coast, this remote lodge is reached by rafting down a 14-mile stretch of the Class II-IV Pacuare River known for its dramatic gorges and surrounding virgin forests. The exclusive (and romantic) lodge is only accessible by raft or suspension bridge and runs without electricity (gas is used to cook, shower water is heated by solar). Gourmet meals are included, and the palm-thatched bungalows, lodge rooms and river-front suites are illuminated by candlelight.



NOTE: There are only 7 GARDEN-view bungalows available (pictured to the right) for the \$549 pp pre-excursion price (first come, first served); then upgrades apply as follows: JUNGLE-View Bungalows (2 available) @ \$30 pp/night surcharge; RIVER-View Bungalows (5 available) @ \$60 pp/night surcharge; And the EXCLUSIVE (2450 sq ft) Linda Vista Suites (4 available) @ \$150 pp/night surcharge. 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## PRE-EXTENSION

- 5 April (Tue) Depart USA; Arrive San Jose, Costa Rica.  
Make your own way to **MARRIOTT SAN JOSE** (3 miles away by \$10-\$15 per taxi) for (1) one night.
- 6 April (Wed) Early morning ground transfer (two hour drive) from San Jose to Pacuare River put-in.  
**White Water Rafting Expedition** – part 1, to the **PACUARE JUNGLE LODGE** for a (2) two-night stay.  
Three meals (B-L-D) included.
- 7 April (Thu) **Morning Naturalist-Guided Hike** through the jungle to a waterfall in search of wildlife.  
FULL FREE DAY to splash in the river, stand still under a waterfall, order a spa treatment, etc.  
Three meals (B-L-D) included.
- 8 April (Fri) **White Water Rafting Expedition** – part 2, from lodge to Pacuare River take-out (Sarapiquí).
