

This historic landmark hotel is located on the former plantation of New Orleans' founding father, Jean Baptiste LeMoyne De Beinville. It's smack dab in the middle of the Central Business District, just a hop and a skip away from the French Quarter, the RiverWalk, a collection of galleries and museums, and the new hipster Warehouse District (AKA Arts District, including Emeril Lagasse's original restaurant).

Decorated with traditional Old World elegance and intimate charm, this 3-star boutique hotel features ornate chandeliers and high ceilings. Almost all of its 60 guestrooms offer soaring 18-foot ceilings and crown molding (some with original exposed brick and most

with luminous ten-foot-tall windows), antique furnishings, imported bed linens, MP3 docking stations, complimentary Wi-Fi, and compulsory telephone, writing desk, and television. Bathrooms have marble floors, granite vanities, toiletries and a hair dryer.

Daily breakfast is included and served at the Ruby Slipper Cafe next door

(don't worry... if you want to sleep in after a night of debauchery, it's served all day). Guests who want to work out or swim can use the fitness center and pool at the nearby Sheraton for \$10 per day.
