

#### **Snapshot Overview**

The trip to the **LAKE SHASTA CAVERNS** begins with a scenic catamaran cruise across Shasta Lake, followed by a fun bus ride to the cave entrance and then an informative tour of what some geologists consider one of the most beautiful limestone caves in the Nation. The caverns trip involves some exercise: walking a winding trail to/from the boat, and then walking up and down several hundred stairs inside the caverns. Wear comfortable shoes and a light jacket. The inside temperature of the caverns is about 57 degrees Fahrenheit year round.

**TURTLE BAY EXPLORATION PARK** is a 300-acre campus along the banks of the Sacramento River with educational and entertaining activities and experiences that interpret the relationship between humans and nature. The Park tells the story of the region and its people through a museum, underground aquarium, Native American history and exhibits, interactive experiments, and rotating art exhibits; wildlife exhibits; Paul Bunyan's Forest Camp; California's largest North American butterfly house; an amphitheater; and (across the Sacramento River), the McConnell Arboretum and Gardens. The gardens feature 20 acres of Mediterranean climate display gardens, a children's garden, medicinal garden and two beautiful and unique water features. Enjoy a snack and refreshments at the Turtle Bay Café, which has captivating views of the Sacramento River as well as the world-famous Sundial Bridge. Park Map: www.turtlebay.org/map

The **SUNDIAL BRIDGE** in Redding is the most unique pedestrian bridge in America. Featuring a 210-foot pylon that acts as the gnomon of a sundial, the bridge is the largest manmade sundial in the world, casting its enormous shadow on a giant dial plate bordered by a natural garden to the north. The designer of this world famous bridge is an artist in his own right. Award winning Spanish architect, artist, and engineer Santiago Calatrava is one of the World's most famous and sought-after bridge designers. The bridge is open seven days a week from 6 a.m. to Midnight, and there is no charge to view or walk across the bridge.

Shortly before his death, architect Frank Lloyd Wright designed the **PILGRIM CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH** in Redding. It was completed in 1958 with 23 steel and concrete triangular pillars that give the building a tent-like quality. Mr. Wright (in tongue in cheek) referred to the church design as "pole and boulder Gothic." His thought was that the church would represent the ancient dwelling of Israel, a symbol of temporary, migratory and transient lives. Nearby, the grounds of Redding's City Hall are meticulously landscaped and offer visitors a chance to meander along paved walkways through the **CITY HALL SCULPTURE PARK** – home to permanent and touring works of stone, metal and Mosaiculture art pieces.
