## DESCRIPTION:

Sit back, relax and enjoy the spectacular scenery... or stand up, dance and party your way through snowy mountains. Join us in a fun-filled weekend with travel friends and friends of friends. Although you will journey together by train and stay in the same hotel as the rest of the group, upon arrival you are free to do exactly what you want, when you want. You control how engaged or independent you want to be... join others for meals and cocktails and activities... explore and dine exclusively on your own... or partake in a combination of a little of both. The choice is yours. Whatever your travel style, leave yourself plenty of unplanned time. Some of the best travel moments are those you stumble upon or spontaneously create.

## SNAPSHOT OVERVIEW:

This "Biggest Little City in the World" is both a gateway to adventure in Nevada and a somewhat down-market version of Las Vegas with miles of gleaming slot machines and poker tables, along with tacky wedding chapels and quickie divorce courts. While the town itself may not be much to look at, its setting (at the foot of the snowcapped Sierra Nevada with the Truckee River winding through the center) is superb. The casinos are concentrated downtown, along Virginia Street on either side of the railroad tracks.

In addition to casino music/entertainment and strategic gaming of 21, slots, craps, roulette, or poker, you can visit:

- National Automobile Museum (boasting several celebrity automobiles that personify romance, power, money, politics and Hollywood – including cars previously owned by Al Jolson, Elvis Presley, Lana Turner, Frank Sinatra, James Dean, John Wayne, and others). Admission price is \$10 for adults and \$8 for seniors.
- Fleischmann Planetarium and Science Center (housing an observatory, many fascinating exhibits and an out of this world Planetarium show). Admission price is \$6 for adults and \$4 for seniors.
- Nevada Museum of Art (the four-level structure inspired by the state's Black Rock Desert is a work of art in its own right and houses both permanent and traveling exhibitions). Admission price is \$10 for adults and \$8 for seniors.
- Squaw Valley, Alpine, Northstar, Mount Rose, and/or Kirkwood ski resorts, all of which can be reached by Harrah's shuttles for \$15 per person, round trip. Ski lift tickets and equipment can be purchased/rented separately.
- Rink on the River (ice skating on the plaza along the Truckee River). Admission price is \$7.50 for adults and \$5.50 for seniors; skate rental is \$2.50.

HARRAH'S RENO ([www.harrahreno.com](http://www.harrahreno.com)) – This branch of Harrah's, long a dominant player in the casino hotel market, is smack in the middle of downtown. The rooms are modern, clean, and comfortable. The service, long a Harrah's hallmark, is excellent. Guests enjoy a variety of touches such as 24-hour room service, an extensive health club, pool, and in-house massage. Evening entertainment centers around Sammy's (named for Sammy Davis, Jr.), where Vegas-type shows feature topless gals and special guest entertainers.

- **CANCELLATION & REFUNDS:** For cancellations made after posting of deposit, a \$50 cancellation fee will apply. For cancellations made after final payment, 100% nonrefundable.
