Snapshot Overview

After 50 TBE hosted expeditions, we're offering our first adventure on the high seas – A 15-night voyage, beginning in **FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA**. After two nights at sea, we port in **FIVE CARIBBEAN ISLANDS** before embarking on an eight-night transatlantic crossing. Disembarkation is at the legendary **SOUTHAMPTON, ENGLAND**. From there, we'll take the train to LONDON where you can catch your flight home, or optionally stay 3 nights and enjoy "the Big Smoke".

For those (optionally) extending, after disembarkation... England's capital has got it all. And she flaunts it. From the revived East End to the swish haunts of Notting Hill, **LONDON** accessorizes its heritage beauty with couldn't-give-a-damn street cred. This feisty lady is effortlessly cool with glorious parks, historic squares, monuments galore, museums piled with colonial swag, galleries where art soothes/surprises, and stages attracting theatre's hottest talent. Multi-ethnic and eccentric, the British capital lets you eat and shop your way around the globe. The King's Road punks and Carnaby Street swingers may be long gone, but this shoppers' Valhalla has reinvented itself as a modern metropolis. And, while historical architectural icons still peer over the city, the London Eye and Wembley Stadium provide a skyline for the new renaissance.

After disembarking from our transatlantic adventure, board the TBE chartered bus to our downtown London hotel. The drive will take about 90 minutes. Upon arrival, settle into the modern digs with a little bit of time to grab lunch and freshen up before heading out on our private TBE afternoon bus tour of the city. The rest of that night is at leisure, and the next two full days are completely free to lasso whatever piques your interest – plenty of time to enjoy Afternoon high tea, crawl English pub to pub, or fly high on the London Eye... meander through the British Museum, Churchill's War Rooms, and/or the National Art Gallery... take in Westminster Abby, the Tower of London (and her crown jewels), Big Ben, St. Paul's Cathedral and/or Shakespeare's Globe Theater... catch the changing of the guards at Buckingham Palace... fit-bit your way through Kensington Gardens, Hyde Park, the East End Street Art or alongside the River Thames... shop Harrods' (don't miss the food court in the basement), Notting Hill, or any of the dozens of trendy neighborhoods. Tours abound: walking, biking, boating, and/or bussing, or adventure out on your own. Themed tours include Sherlock Holmes, Shakespeare, Downton Abbey, and the Beatles, as well as Harry Potter and the DaVinci Code. With both days fully unscheduled, there is plenty of time to explore out of town venues such as Hampton Court, Windsor Castle, Stonehenge, Oxford, Bath, Salisbury, and the Cotswolds. As always, TBE will offer guidance and assistance if any of these tickle your fancy!

About the Ship

Meet Independence of the Seas, a marvel of maritime engineering, loaded with incredible onboard experiences. Multi-course meals are served in the main dining room, as well as upgraded specialty dining (for an extra charge) at Chops Grille Steakhouse, Giovanni's Table, or Johnny Rockets. For more casual dining, try the Windjammer Café (buffet), Jade Sushi (Asian-fusion cuisine), Brasserie 30, Sorrento's Pizza, or the Café Promenade (coffee and pastries/snacks). Room service is also available if you prefer eating privately in your own stateroom. In addition 10 pools and Jacuzzis, a full day spa, nightly entertainment, and a casino, the onboard action never stops – hop on the FlowRider surf simulator, climb the rock wall, ice skate, walk/run the track, or hit the links at the mini-golf course. End your night in any of the 22 bars, clubs/lounges, like Dog & Badger English Pub or Vintages wine bar.

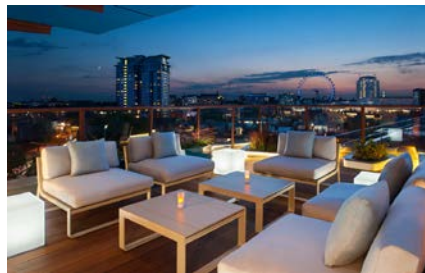
